## Orderly Chaos

Finished Size: 52" x 68"
Finished Block Size: 8" x 8"

The blocks in this quilt were made by repeating black fabric in the patches for each block, then all the blocks were partially bordered with the same black fabric. The resulting pattern makes it difficult to find the original block. The creative process used for the border is fun can easily be used for other quilts.

FABRIC TIP
Choose bright contrasting prints without a lot of pattern so that they appear as solid fabrics from a distance.

## SUPPLIES:

Suggested Book: New Cuts for New Quilts! By Karla Alexander


Sewing machine in good working order
Basic rotary cutting and sewing supplies
Several pieces of blank paper
Safety pin
12 1/2" x 12-1/2" acrylic square ruler
OPTIONAL: 2 yds white flannel for design wall

## FABRIC:

$25 / 8$ yards of black tone on tone or solid fabric for blocks and border
3 yards TOTAL of prints in assorted colors (for example, turquoise, green, red, blue, purple, yellow, gold, orange and black) for blocks and border
5/8 yard of fabric for binding
3 1/4 yards of fabric for backing

## PLEASE PRE-CUT FABRIC FOR BLOCKS PRIOR TO CLASS

## CUTTING FOR BLOCKS:

From the prints in assorted colors for the blocks, cut a total of 35 squares, 9 1/2" x $91 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
