

# Savanna

Finished Size: 64" x 81"

Block Size: 8 1/2" x 8 1/2"

I had a lot of fun using jungle prints to make this quilt. Of course this design will work with any mix of light and dark fabrics. The fabric requirements below lists the necessary yardage as well as the total number of squares needed if you instead choose to work from your stash. Enjoy!

## SUPPLIES:

Suggested Pattern: Savanna

Sewing machine in good working order  
Basic rotary cutting and sewing supplies  
9 1/2" x 9 1/2" square ruler – or larger  
OPTIONAL: 2 yds white flannel for design wall

## Materials

- 1/3 yard each of 6 different dark value prints for blocks  
OR a variety of 24 squares, 9" x 9"
- 1/3 yard each of 6 different light prints for blocks  
OR a variety of 24 squares, 9" x 9"
- 1/3 yard of fabric for inner narrow border
- 1 3/8 yard fabric for outer wide border
- 2/3 yard fabric for binding
- 72" x 89" piece of batting
- 5 1/4 fabric yards for backing

Suggested Ruler: **Curves for Squares CGRKA1 by Creative Grids**

PLEASE PRE-CUT FABRIC FOR BLOCKS PRIOR TO CLASS, REFER TO THE PATTERN FOR INSTRUCTIONS.
