Finished Size: 52" x 73"

Finished Block Size: 10 1/2" x 10 1/2"

Learn to use lots of medium to large-scale contrasting prints all within the same quilt. If you feel inspired to add an extra print or two - well you can! You'll design your blocks as you go and will leave with a head full of ideas, possibilities and techniques that you will use over and over again. This is a fun quilt to make and easy to adjust it's size.

## SUPPLIES:

Suggested Book: Color Shuffle! By Karla Alexander

Sewing machine in good working order

Basic rotary cutting and sewing supplies

Several pieces of blank paper

Safety pin

12 1/2" x 12-1/2" acrylic square ruler

OPTIONAL: 2 yds white flannel for design wall



## FABRIC:

2/3 yard EACH of 6 different dark red and purple prints for blocks

2/3 yard EACH of 6 different light green, pink, and yellow prints for blocks

5/8 yard of binding fabric

4 3/4 yards of backing fabric
